<p>Established Patient, Straightforward Follow Up</p> <p>\$150</p>	<p>A follow up visit for a patient seen and diagnosed with a skin condition by Dr. DiGiorgio in a prior in-office visit. (Do NOT book this for a full body skin exam)</p>	<p>Examples include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Follow up for one mole that has been previously examined and diagnosed and is being monitored. ● Follow up and/or treatment for previously diagnosed warts or molluscum. ● Follow up for stable acne, rosacea or eczema for refills only, when no change in medications, management, or laboratory studies are needed.
<p>New Patient or Established Patient</p> <p>Straightforward Visit</p> <p>\$150</p>	<p>An established patient with one new straightforward problem or a new patient with one straightforward problem. (Do NOT book this for a full body skin exam.)</p>	<p>Acne consultation: This includes a detailed examination of the areas of your skin that are affected by acne, explanation of the diagnosis, and a customized treatment plan including medications, long-term projected plan, and counseling.</p> <p>Rosacea consultation: This includes a detailed examination of the areas of your skin that are affected by rosacea, explanation of the diagnosis, and a customized treatment plan including medications, long-term projected plan, and counseling. (Laser treatments for rosacea may be recommended, are considered cosmetic, and will incur an additional fee).</p> <p>New suspicious lesion visit: If you have one lesion of concern that you would like examined (Dr. DiGiorgio encourages a full body skin exam if one has not been performed by a Board-Certified Dermatologist within the last 12 months).</p> <p>One new rash limited to a single area of the body: This includes a detailed</p>

		<p>examination of your rash, explanation of the diagnosis and a treatment plan. Occasionally, this may require a skin biopsy to establish a diagnosis. (If a new rash covers the entire body please see below).</p> <p>New warts/molluscum visit: This includes examination of all warts or molluscum to ensure the diagnosis, the treatment of all lesions, and a plan for follow up examination.</p>
<p>New Patient or Established Patient</p> <p>Comprehensive Visit</p> <p>\$300</p>		<p>Full Body skin exam or Upper body skin exam (Dr. DiGiorgio discourages only upper body skin exams). Dr. DiGiorgio will examine your skin from head to toes.</p> <p>Hair loss consultation: Your scalp will be examined and laboratory testing may be ordered to identify possible causes of your hair loss. This visit may also include a skin biopsy if determined to be necessary to establish a diagnosis for your hair loss.</p> <p>Skin rash: Rash that is present on more than one area of the body or all over the body.</p> <p>Moderately complex medical conditions (including second opinions) or eczema, psoriasis, contact dermatitis, or other extensive rashes that are new or not resolving with current treatments.</p>
<p>New Patient or Established Patient</p> <p>Complex Medical Office Visit</p> <p>\$350</p>		<p>Complex medical conditions (including second opinions).</p> <p>Full body skin exam in patients with an extensive history of skin cancer, history of melanoma, or dysplastic nevi.</p>
